## **DISTINCT Keyword**

- The DISTINCT clause removes duplicate rows from a query.
- DISTINCT appears directly after the SELECT clause.
- You can specify multiple columns, which means that the combination of columns must be unique.

## Table 7. DISTINCT Keyword

Keyword	Description	Order of Evaluation
DISTINCT	Eliminates duplicate rows	1


## Example:

SELECT DISTINCT continent, name FROM country ORDER BY continent;

Results:



- 1 SELECT DISTINCT continent
- 2 FROM country
- 3 ORDER BY continent;
